Member Agreement and Area Rules

General Rules

1. K9 Freedom Center will be open only as needed by making advanced group reservations.
2. The swimming pond will be open weather permitting.
3. Pit Bulls are prohibited from K9 Freedom Center.
4. Trash must be disposed of in proper receptacles.
5. Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the property.
6. Alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are NOT allowed anywhere on the property. This is an alcohol and drug free property. Anyone under the influence will be asked to leave the property immediately.
7. No Member is allowed to bring guns, knives or weapons of any kind on to property (no exceptions).
8. Proper shoes must be worn. No flip flops, sandals or high heels.
9. Member will closely supervise any accompanying minor children at all times. Please ensure the safety of the children and the dogs by using appropriate behavior. (i.e. no running, no screaming, no dog chasing)
10. Member will not allow minor children to approach other pets unless permission is given by the pet's owner.
11. All dogs must be current with annual vaccinations, rabies vaccination and licensed to enter fenced area.
12. Member will not bring any sick, injured, or parasite-infested dog into the Facility.
13. All dogs at the facility (unless in the fenced area) must be on-leash and may not remain outside the fenced area except for ingress and egress to the fenced area.
14. Member must be in control and have full view of his/her dog at all times.
15. Member is responsible for any injuries caused by his/her dog. AAES, ESHA, Inc. and Goodman, Genn and Lutz, LLC are not responsible for any injuries caused by any member's dog to any other Member.
16. Member must remove his dog's feces and/or vomit, and place in receptacles provided.
17. Member must pre-register any Agents (dog caregivers). Agents must be 18 years of age or older, must sign an agreement and are subject to the rules.
18. Motorized vehicles are not permitted anywhere except on designated roads.
19. Parking allowed only in designated parking area.
20. We are a facility of friends who help and respect each other. Gossiping and spreading rumors is considered unacceptable behavior and is contrary to the principles of the K9 Freedom Center. Such behavior will be grounds for immediate dismissal from the K9 Freedom Center.
21. AAES retains absolute discretion to terminate membership if Member—in AAES's determination—fails to obey these or any other rules.

Fenced Area Rules

1. All dogs should be neutered or spayed. Intact dogs are accepted – unless in heat and will have designated visit times.
2. Dogs must be at least 30 feet from the gate when other dogs are entering. Upon ingress, if dogs are greeting, incoming member must bellow, "Gate!" and wait for welcoming dogs to vacate before entering.
3. Member will not allow children under eight (8) years old into the fenced area.
4. Member will bellow, "Guard!" and/or "Fight!" (as the situation merits) if member notices dogs behaving in a dangerous or potentially dangerous manner of heightened stimulation. Upon hearing either of these warnings, all members will recall, retrieve, or collect his/her dog immediately.
5. Member must be in good physical condition and of sound mind to be able to control his/her dog.
6. All dogs must walk on their own through the Fenced Area, and at no time be carried (unless sick or injured).
7. Each Member may bring no more than two dogs per person into the Fenced Area – unless otherwise arranged with Management.
8. Each Guest must sign a Guest Agreement in order to enter the Fenced Area, and are subject to these rules.
9. Member must accompany Guest at all times while in the Fenced Area.
10. Member will not allow any non-Member dog to enter the Fenced Area.
11. Member will not allow him/herself, guests, or children to swim in the pond except for the emergency rescue of a dog or human.
12. Member will not allow his/her dog to hump other dogs nor allow his/her dog to be humped by other dogs.
13. Member will take immediate action if his/her dog displays annoying, aggressive or intimidating behavior (posturing, growling, biting, and toy possessiveness) to another dog or Member, guest, or activity participant.

Member should do whatever he/she has to prevent the behavior from recurring (time-out, redirect behavior, etc.). If behavior cannot be corrected or redirected, Member will have to leave the Facility.

14. Member may allow rough play as long as it is consensual between the playing dogs. Member will not allow rough play and chasing if any of the dogs involved is not comfortable with the situation.
15. Member will not allow his/her dog to dig.
16. Member will not use spiked/prong collars, choke chains, electric shock or Gentle Lead collar anywhere on the property.
17. While in the exercise area please remove flea collars. Also, to protect other dogs (playmates) from toxicity, please refrain from applying flea spot at least 72 hours prior to coming to the K9 Freedom Center.
18. Member must have possession of a dog leash at all times. Retractable leashes are not allowed.
19. Dogs are encouraged to be on the leash while being introduced to the perimeter and other dogs in the exercise area.
20. No food or drinks allowed within the fenced in area.
21. Member shall not permit any animal other than his dog(s) to be at the Facility.
22. Member's dog may only use areas designated for his/her group.
23. Member may only bring into the Fenced Area tennis balls and Frisbees (no high value toys). If a particular toy causes dogs to fight, that toy must be removed immediately.
